In this Privacy policy, we aim to provide clear and transparent information on how we handle personal data. We do everything we can to guarantee your privacy and therefore handle personal data with care. Paul Meijering Metalen bv complies in all cases with the applicable laws and regulations, including the General Data Protection Regulation.

This entails that we in any case:

Processing of personal data of Employees

Personal data of employees are processed by Paul Meijering Metalen bv for the following purpose(s): Performance of the employment contract.

The basis for these personal details is: The employment agreement.

Your personal data will be stored by Paul Meijering Metalen bv for the purpose of the aforementioned processing(s) for the period:

For the period that one has a contract and thereafter only in the financial administration for up to 7 years.

Provision to third parties

We may provide the data you provide to us to third parties if this is necessary for carrying out the purposes described above.

For example, we use a third party for:

- Providing the internet environment of the AVG programme;
- Taking care of the (financial) administration;
- Providing newsletters and invitations.

We never pass on personal data to other parties with whom we have not concluded a processor agreement. Naturally, we make the necessary agreements with these parties (processors) to ensure the security of your personal data. Furthermore, we will not provide the data you provide to other parties, unless required and permitted by law. An example of this is when the police request (personal) data from us as part of an investigation. In such a case, we are obliged to cooperate and hand over these data. We may also share personal data with third parties if you give us your written consent.

Within the EU

We do not provide personal data to parties located outside the EU.

Minors

We only process personal data of minors (persons younger than 16 years old) if written consent has been given by the parent, guardian or legal representative.

Retention period

Paul Meijering Metalen bv does not retain personal data longer than necessary for the purpose for which they were provided or required by law.

Security

We have taken appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect personal data of yours from unlawful processing, for example;

- All persons who may have access to your data on behalf of Paul Meijering Metalen bv are bound to secrecy.
- We maintain a username and password policy on all our systems;
- We pseudonymise and ensure the encryption of personal data if warranted;
- We make backups of personal data to restore it in case of physical or technical incidents;
- We regularly test and evaluate our measures;
- Our employees are informed about the importance of protecting personal data.

Rights regarding your data

You have the right to inspect, correct or delete the personal data we have received from you. You can also object to the processing of all or part of your personal data by us or one of our processors. You also have the right to have us transfer the data you have provided to yourself or on your behalf directly to another party. We may ask you to identify yourself before we can comply with the aforementioned requests.

Should we process your personal data on the basis of a consent given by you to this effect, you always have the right to withdraw this consent.

Complaints

If you have a complaint about the processing of your personal data, please contact us directly. If we cannot work it out with you, we will of course find this very annoying. You always have the right to lodge a complaint with the Personal Data Authority, the supervisory authority in the field of privacy protection.
